- Mentor
 - Definition: Mentoring is an intentional relationship of trust whereby a person shares something of value—wisdom, advice, support, learnings—with another person that empowers his personal/professional growth.
- Disciple
 - Definition: Discipling is an intentional relationship of trust whereby a person presents/explains the fundamental truths and practices of the Christian faith to someone who is young in their understanding of what it means to follow Christ.
